Science generates solutions for everyday life and helps us to answer the great mysteries of the universe. In other words, science is one of the most important channels of knowledge. It has a specific role, as well as a variety of functions for the benefit of our society: creating new knowledge, improving education, and increasing the quality of our lives. Based upon the above principles the Science Society Nilamani Mahavidyalaya, Rupsa, Balasore is formed to inculcate the ideas among the Faculty Members, Students and the masses.

Its Aims and Objectives and constitution are given below.

1. Name: THE SCIENCE SOCIETY: It is called the Science Society, Nilamani Mahavidyalaya, Rupsa, Balasore.

2. Aims & Objectives of Science Society:

- a. To inculcate a scientific temper and develop a scientific bent of mind.
- b. To organise curricular and co-curricular activities among the science students.
- c. To popularise Science Education by means of popular Lectures, Discussions and Science Exhibitions.
- d. To invite eminent scientists to deliver lectures.
- e. To organise scientific essay, debate and quiz competitions among the science students of the college.
- f. To conduct Surveys and organise Study Tour.
- g. To undertake such other scientific activities as are decided upon by the Executive Body and approved by the Principal.
- h. To commemorate/observe the birthday of eminent scientists for their outstanding contribution to the cause of humanity.
- i. To encourage students to engage themselves in scientific research to expand the frontiers of knowledge.

(3) Membership:

- 1. All the students of the science and faculty shall be members of the science society.
- 2. Member of the staff (both Teaching and Non Teaching) of the science faculty shall be Associate members.

(4) Management:

The management of the affairs of the science society shall be vested on the Executive committee Members.

(5) The Executive Committee:

The Executive Committee consists of the following members:

- 1.President-Principal (Ex-Officio)
- 2. Vice-President-Sr. most teachers of any of the Science Department to be nominated by the principal.
- 3. Secretary and Asst. Secretary (To be selected from the Science Stream)

(6) Function of the Society:

Every year the Annual Day of the Society is observed on 28th February on the occasion of observation of National Science Day. This day is observed to mark the discovery of the Raman effect by Indian physicist Sir C. V. Raman on 28th February 1928. Different Competitions and science exhibition are organised among the students. Toppers of different departments are awarded on this day.
